tempering. Its slightly everted rim resembles that of a Colono-Indian cup illustrated by Noël Hume (1962b: 2) (Plate 18).

Horse Tack:

Harness-leather ornament (100J1-4). Copper alloy attached to thin sheet brass, remains of 2 fastening hooks; 2 cm. in length (Plate 16).

Miscellaneous Hardware:

Cotter pin (100C2-1). Thin copper alloy sheet, 1.5 cm. long (Plate 16).

Trade Items:

Tinkling cone (90T1-1). Thin copper alloy sheet, 3.5 cm. long (Plate 16).

Spiral (100K1-3). Possibly a trade item? Thin copper alloy sheet. Strip curved around rod or shaft to form spiral - decorative? Length: 1.8 cm. (Plate 16).

Blue glass bead (90T1-11). Ovoid (Plate 17).

Clear glass bead (100H1-16). Oblate. Broken along hole (Plate 17).

Yellow [?] glass bead (100R3-71). Badly corroded (Plate 17).

Scissor blade tip (100C1-1). Iron.

Fish hook (90Y1-1). Iron (Plate 14).

Decorative insignia [?] fragment (100S2-1). Copper alloy, flat back with convex face (Plate 16).

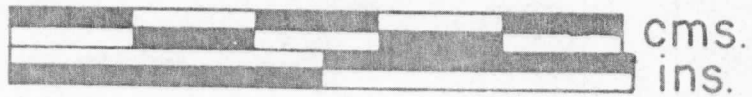
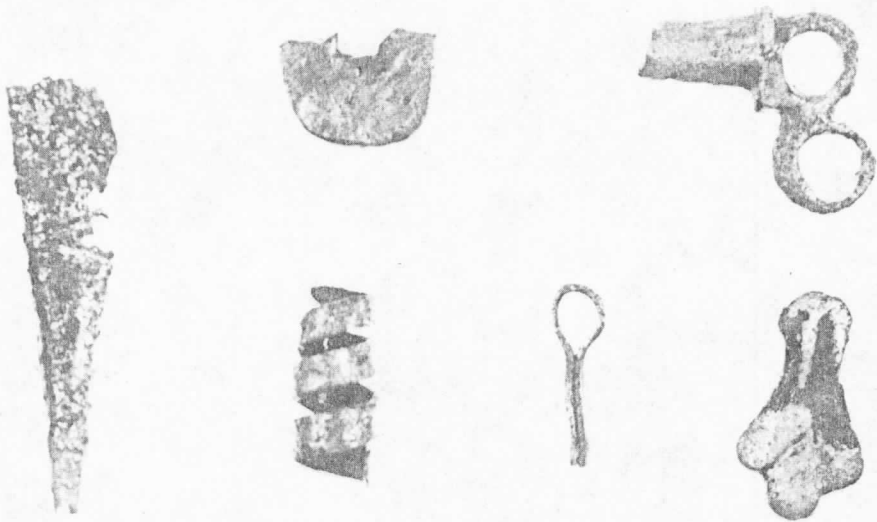


Plate 16. Small finds: tinkling cone, sheet brass scrap and spiral, cotter pin, decorative fragments.

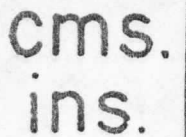
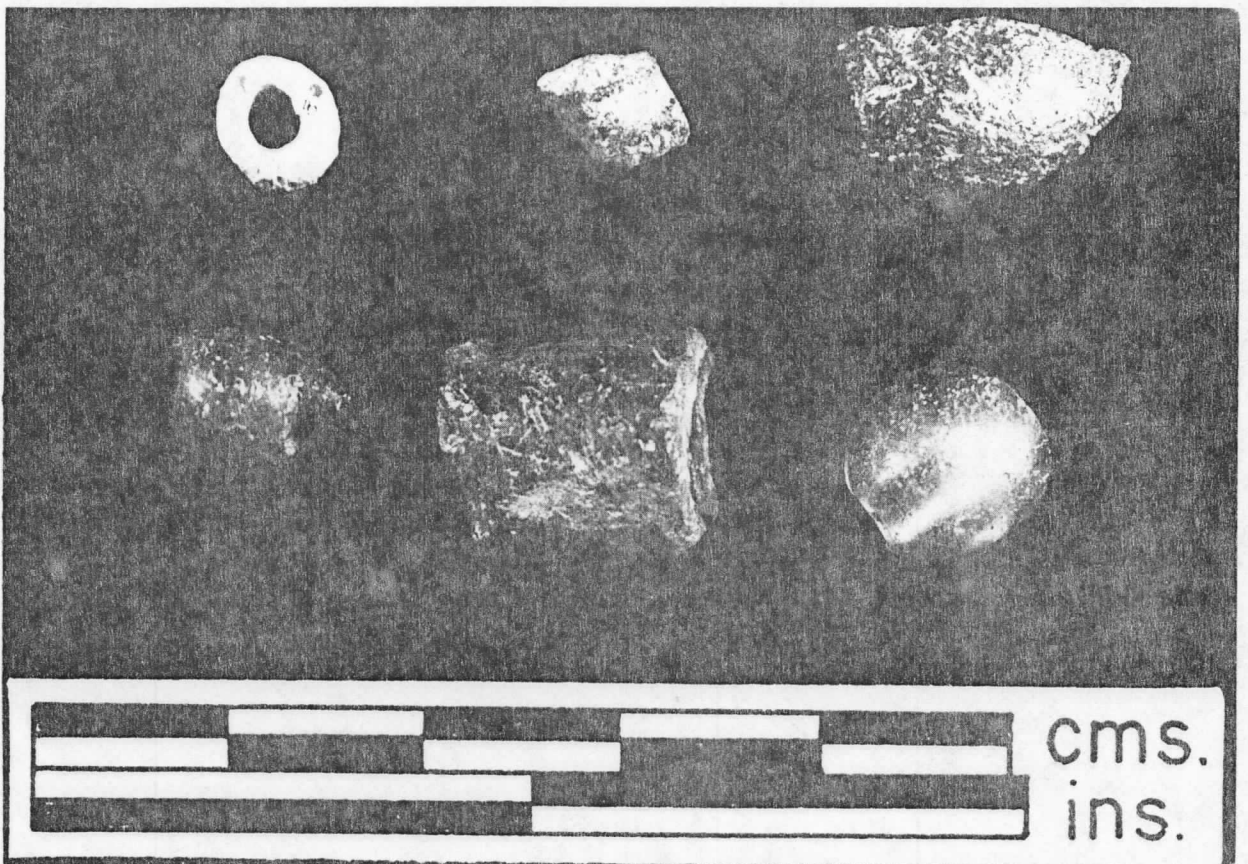


Plate 17. Trade beads and aboriginal stone beads from Fort Christanna.
