- 12 portions of stems of white man's clay pipe.
- ✓ 26 very small white beads, European made.
- 3 parts of a door lock.
- 4 parts of door hinges.
- 2 S-shaped crane irons.
- 1 cow bell.
- pieces of old iron, (8 x 6), cut by a cold chisel.
- 8 pieces of hoop iron, various sizes.
- 1 flat silver ring.
- 1 gold wedding ring.
- 1 silver ear drop.
- 1 brass buckle.
- 1 top of Lorraine cross.
- 2 fine-tooth combs.
- parts of hen eggshells.
- 4 pins.
- 17 fossils.
- 8 carbonized corn cobs, from corb shocks.
- 1 carbonized potato from fireplace.
