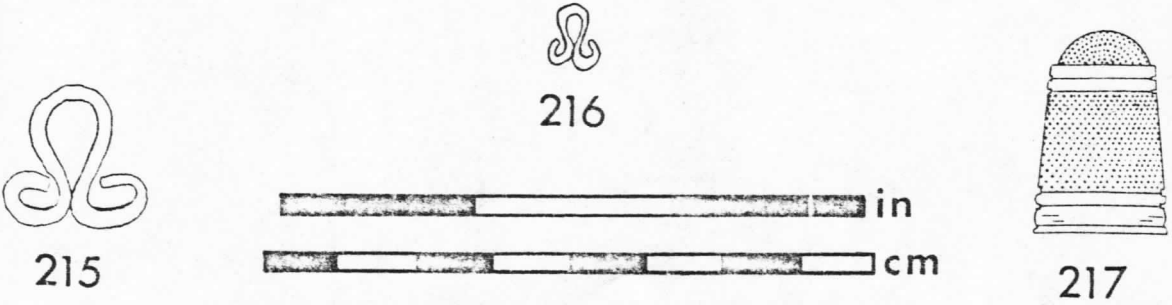
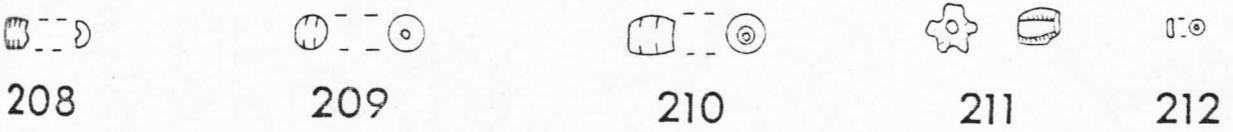
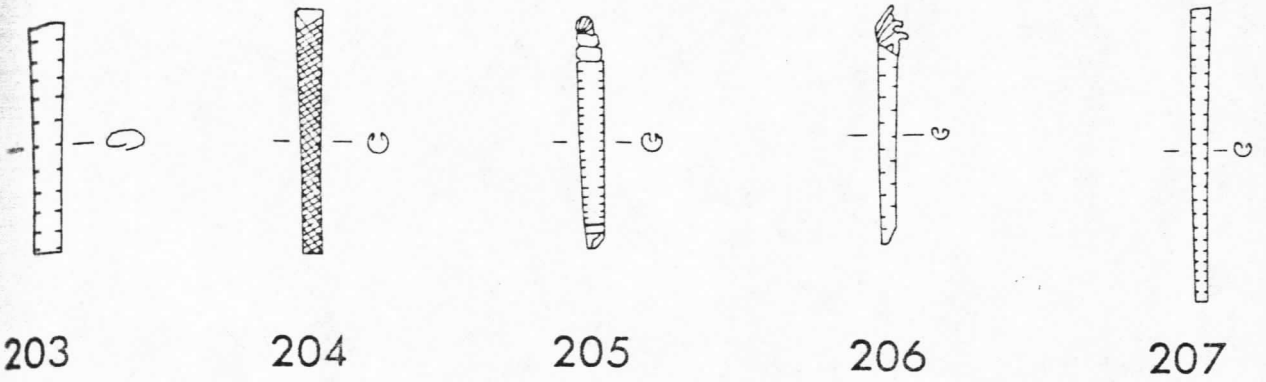
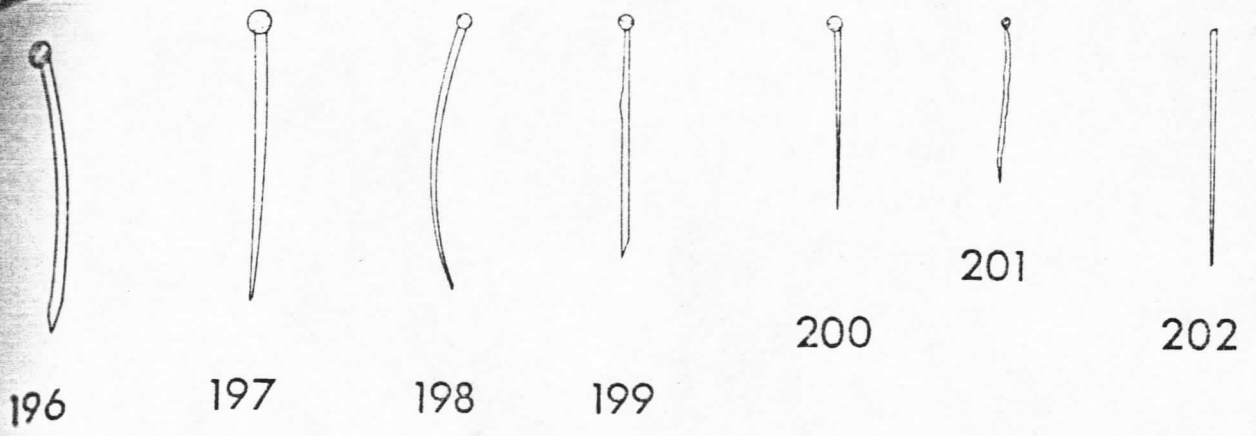


FIGURE 38: Small finds including pins, aglets, beads, hooks, and thimble. Actual size.

- 208. Bead, glass. Opaque white; oval shape with only one half intact. GL 130C.
  
- 209. Bead, glass. Opaque white; circular shape with slightly flattened ends. GL 130A.
  
- 210. Bead, glass. Opaque white with brown surface decay; oval with flattened ends. GL 126A.
  
- 211. Bead, glass. Opaque amber with brown surface decay; oval with five flutes. GL 124C.
  
- 212. Seed bead, glass. Opaque yellow; flattened disc. GL 102A.
  
- 213. Bead, glass. Opaque amber with white surface decay; circular and slightly recessed on one end; one half only. GL 13A.
  
- 214. Button, glass. Black glass swirled into dome shape; iron eye. GL 106A.
  
- 215. Hook eye, iron. GL 127A.
  
- 216. Hook eye, tinned-brass. GL 127A.
  
- 217. Thimble, brass. Tapering cylinder with stamped dot indentations; domed crown indented all over with dots applied separately. GL 126A.
